# Scope of the Workgroup

Discuss and offer recommendations on:

- Salt use tracking
  - ✓ Uniform metrics for data comparability and Region-wide trend analyses
- BMP Tracking
  - ✓ Process for tracking iterative BMP adoption for continuous improvement
  - ✓ Monitoring success of BMPs
- Focused tracking for highest intensity developed areas
- Funding sources to support this effort

# Workgroup Focus Areas

## *Audiences:*

- ✓ Public and Private sectors
- ✓ Reporting needs/interests differ: operators to decision-makers

## *Key Considerations*

- ✓ Begin tracking at “coarse” level, move to “refined” metrics in time.
- ✓ Tracking starts with operations, continues with post-storm calculations, and culminates in reporting.
- ✓ Automated equipment can facilitate reporting, including locational info, but most reporting will be done manually at present.
- ✓ Emergency operations impact the ability to attend to non-essential actions, like tracking and reporting.

# Workgroup Priority Topics

- Develop metrics to link level of service to BMP effectiveness for:
  - ✓ Roads
  - ✓ Parking lots, and
  - ✓ Sidewalks.
- Focus BMP reporting on
  - ✓ Modest set of predefined BMPs
  - ✓ Flexibility to report others
- Explore incentives to promote voluntary reporting
  - ✓ Private sector: contracts, certification, and liability relief
  - ✓ Public sector: operational improvements, cost effectiveness, certifications, and future reporting needs

# Action Items:

- Assess metrics currently used and information available to support reporting (Fairfax City, VDOT and Fairfax County)
  - ✓ Size of operation, storm event, equipment are factors that affect ability to track and report
- HOA and Citizens Associations contracting and best practices outreach (D.Lincoln and M.Pierce)
  - ✓ Focus on large land/building owners
- Salt Use by Contractors
  - ✓ Almost all use bagged salt, don't have access to bulk supplies
  - ✓ Access to (public) bulk salt could provide cost savings , and enable better reporting of salt use by contractors

# Action Items (cont.):

- Develop example reporting forms for discussion (DEQ)
  - ✓ Feedback during 2<sup>nd</sup> Workgroup Meeting
  - ✓ Revised approach framed with a Tier 1, 2, and 3 conceptual matrix
  - ✓ Need a baseline to evaluate implementation and effectiveness of BMPs
- Identify Reporting Incentives
  - ✓ This will be a focus during 3<sup>rd</sup> Workgroup meeting
  - ✓ Public and Private sector incentives warrant separate consideration
- Identify/Address Barriers and Opportunities to Adopt BMPs
  - ✓ Recommend organizations identify factors that impede or facilitate BMP use and ways to address them
  - ✓ Close coordination with Traditional BMP workgroup needed

Summarize <b>each winter storm event</b> for which operations were mobilized, using <b>available online information</b> . Reporter notes the start and end date/time of each storm operation. # Recommendations & Products

- Matrix to guide tracking/reporting efforts
  - ✓ Tier 1 (Coarse) to Tier 3 (Fine/Detailed) Example Forms
  - ✓ 6 key categories
- Salt product use reporting
  - ✓ List primary products used; solids and liquids
  - ✓ Document use annually (Tier 1), by Storm (Tier 2) or more precisely (Tier 3)
- BMP Tracking
  - ✓ Document use of BMPs (Tier 1) and extent/location (Tier 3)
  - ✓ Success of BMPs is relative to Level of Service (LOS) goals
- Reporting Incentives
  - ✓ Private sector: contracts, certification, and relief
  - ✓ Public sector: operational improvements and future reporting needs
